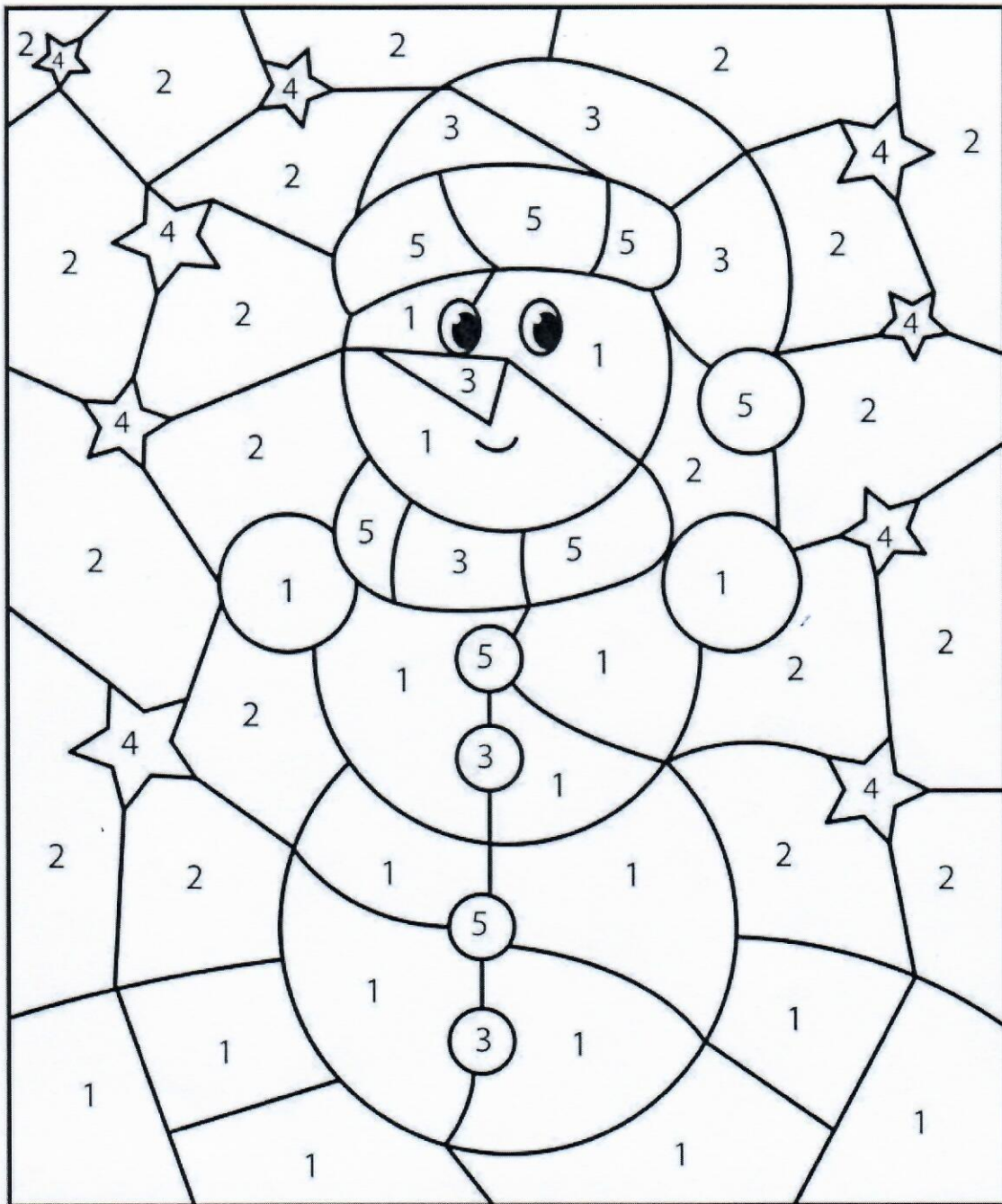
"And now, my dears, you must go to bed, or Santa Claus will not be able to find your stockings."

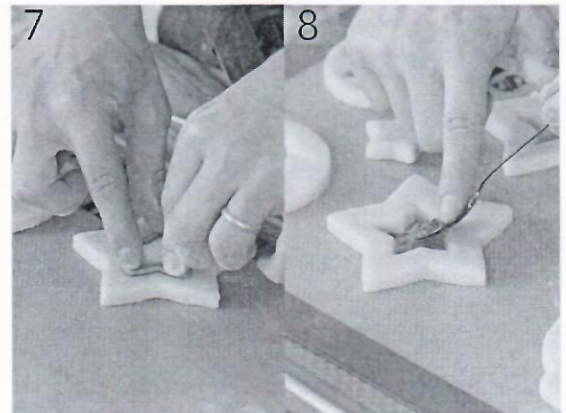
STAINED GLASS COOKIES

INGREDIENTS:

- .1 cup butter (226g, room temperature)
- .1 cup granulated sugar (200g)
- .2 eggs
- .4 cups flour (480g, sifted)
- .1/2 cup cornstarch (65g, sifted)
- .3/4 teaspoon salt
- .1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- .1/3 cup hard candies

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 190 °C.
2. Sift the flour, cornstarch and salt into a large bowl and whisk together.
3. Mix butter and sugar together.
4. Add eggs one at a time, then the vanilla.
5. Mix in the dry mixture.
6. Separate dough into two disks. Wrap in plastic and chill for about an hour.
7. Roll chilled dough to 0.6cm thickness.
8. Cut out a shape using a cookie cutter. Cut out the window shape on the inside using a smaller shape.
9. Poke a small hole at the top of the cookie. This is for the ornament hook.
10. Place cookies on a baking sheet.
11. Add hard candies to a ziplock bag. Crush up, then add to the inside of the cookies. Distribute evenly.
12. Bake for 12 minutes at 190 °C, then allow to cool on baking sheet.
13. Add ornament hook if hanging.

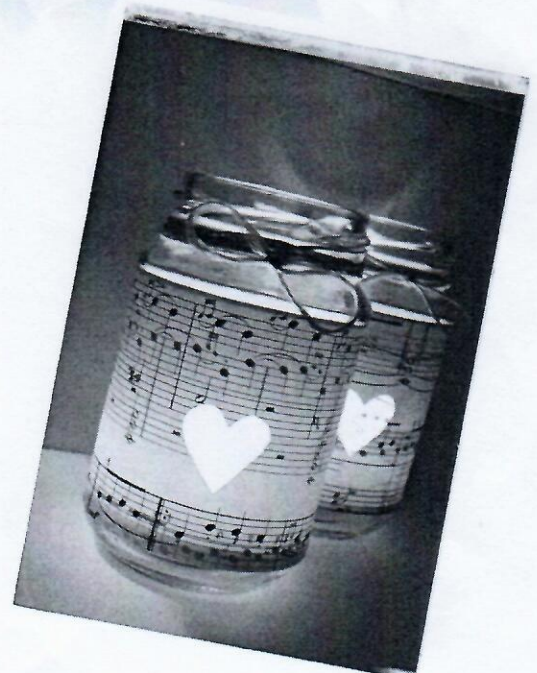

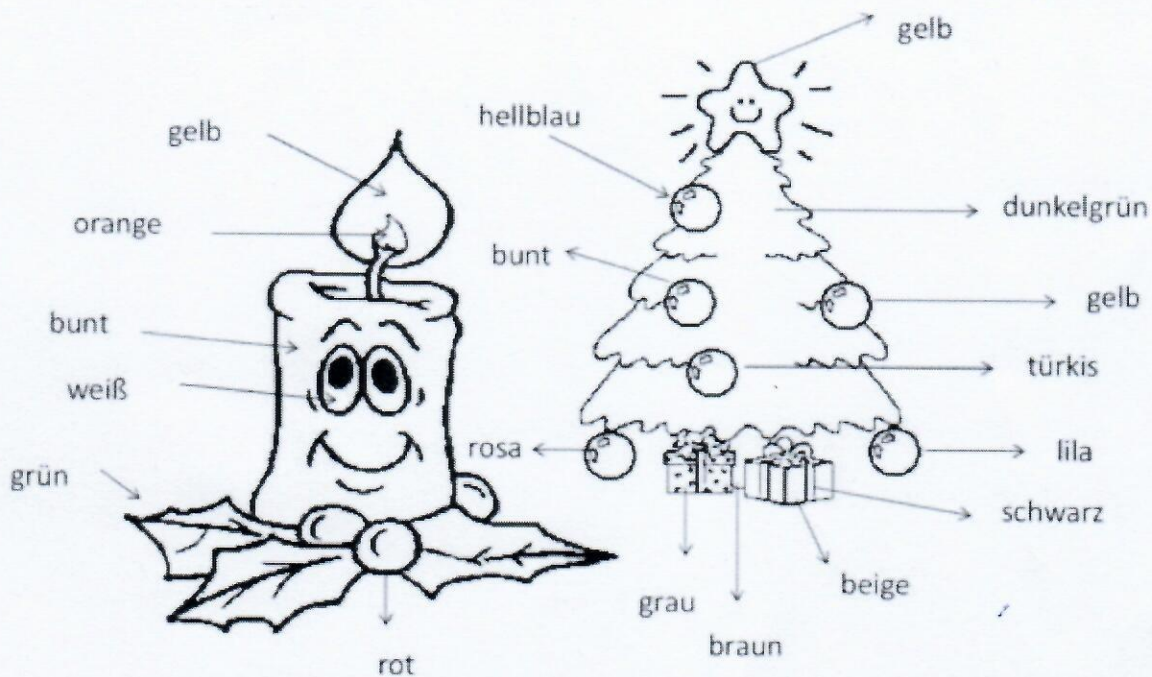

James: It's OK, Inspector Smith. I can help.

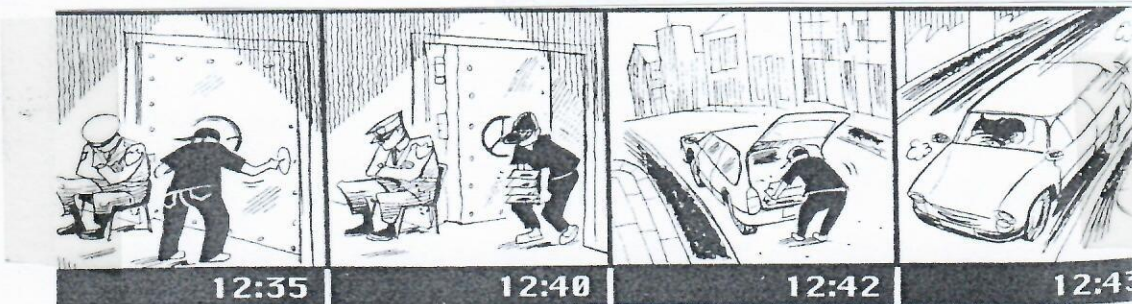
Inspector Smith: Great. Thank you, Mr. Blonde. Here are some photos of the thief. Look at the time on the photos. It's lunchtime today!

James: Can I see your baseball caps?

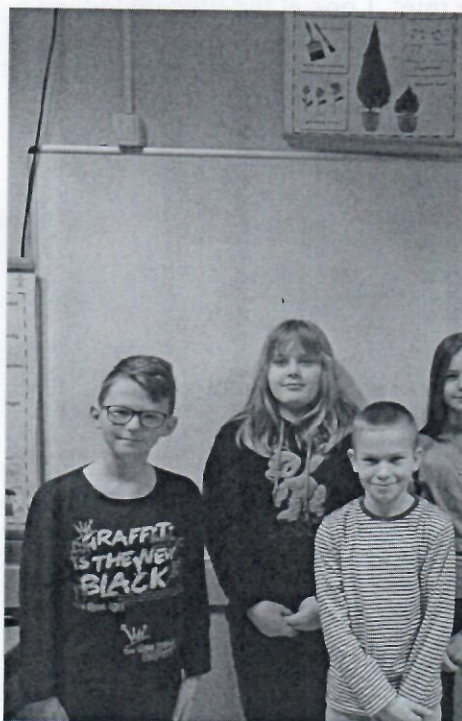
Mrs. Foster: Yes, my cap is in my car.

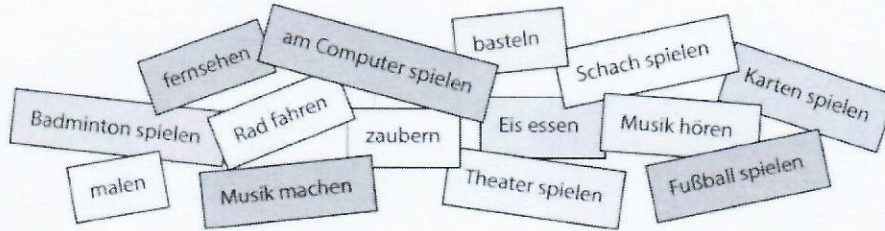
