- Halloween is always celebrated on 31 October.

- **Jack-o-lanterns**: These are hollowed out pumpkins with a face cut into one side. People once carved out beets, potatoes and turnips to use as lanterns on Halloween. Nowadays they carve out pumpkins.
- According to an Irish legend, jack-o-lanterns were named for a man named Jack, who couldn't enter heaven because he was a miser. He couldn't enter hell either, because he had played jokes on the devil. So instead, he had to walk the earth with his lantern until Judgment Day.





Fire: In the old days people lit bonfires to scare away evil spirits. They believed that light had power over darkness. In some places they used to jump over the fire to bring good luck. Today people light candles in pumpkin lanterns and then put them outside their homes to frighten away witches and ghosts.





#### **Bullying**

Bullying is considered as a form of violence. Most common with little children and teenagers, bullying is a sort of violence that is based around making fun of someone's appearance, ethnic origin, religion and fashion sense, among other things. It has also got its own sub forms. Some of them are: physical bullying, mental bullying, cyber - bullying, etc.

Physical bullying consists of punching, kicking, spitting or destroying someone's personal things. Mental bullying is made of calling someone names, swearing at them, threatening them, etc. And finally, cyber - bullying. It is sending inappropriate text messages, threatening calls and texts, posting personal information online, taking someone's pictures without his or her consent.

Bullies are mostly intelligent, though some consider them stupid. They are also handsome, and yet in some media, they are depicted as ugly. The bullies are most likely sporty, fashionable and likeable. They pick on the smaller and weaker children. Bullies use violence, because they were either bullied before, or they are trying to assert their dominance in the school.

Victims of bullies are shy, plain, and unfashionable and they don't have many friends. They aren't sporty, thus the inability to protect themselves.

In our school, bullying is not very common as in the United States or in the United Kingdom, though we do have some minor bullies, whom I will not give names of. The examples of bullies I stated before are mostly true for our bullies, too, but some of them are friendly.

#### **Bullying**

Bullying is unwanted and aggressive abusive behavior among people, especially students. There are many forms of bullying: verbal, mental and physical. With girls, more popular form is verbal or online bullying, while with boys often used form is physical - they usually get into fights.

Victims are usually younger than bullies. They are mostly bullied because of their religion, skin colour, nationality or disabilities, or simply because they are different from others. The victims and the bullies are not the same in any way. The bullies are usually popular and have a lot of friends. They are good – looking and more confident. They are popular with opposite sex, too. The victims' physical characteristics are: hair colour, glasses, overweight, etc. They are new at school or shy and quiet. They prefer to be alone or out of group; simply, they are introverts. They are sometimes scared to tell their teacher about bullying.

In our school, we are trying to be respectful to one another and not bully anyone. There are many arguments, but in our school, we learn about bullying and consequences which can lead to suicide. We also learn about being nice and respectful.

#### **Bullying**

Bullying is a behaviour of a person who hurts or frightens someone whom he thinks is less important or worth, because of some of victim's physical disabilities or characteristics, for example being black, short, having cancer or wearing glasses. Even mental characteristics can be a reason for bullying, for example being shy, stupid or smart (good grades at school). They usually force their victims to do something that they are too lazy to do, such as homework.

Bullies are usually popular and have a lot of friends. They aren't stupid. In fact, bullies can very often be intelligent, but too lazy to do certain things. They are usually good – looking, athletes and popular with the opposite sex. They are often fashion leaders in a school - they wear fashionable clothes. A lot of bullies have been bullied themselves.

Victims are different colour, religion or sexual orientation. Bullies can find a very little detail that can be a reason for argument, such as wearing glasses or being red haired. The victims can also be new at school, shy and that is a characteristic that leads to bullying.

In our school, physical bullying is not so often, because of great attention of our security guard and some teachers. But, mental bullying is one that can't be easily stopped, because teachers see it only when somebody starts fighting because of it and even the security guard doesn't know that it exists. Students aren't the only ones that are being mentally bullied and the teachers are victims, too, but nobody is trying to stop it.
